



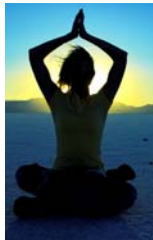

How about a project update?

Since late last year and probably through this month of February, our project focus will continue to be on finishing up everything we started. As you all know, any one project that's supposed to take 10 hours can turn into a 40 hour project once walls are opened up and the reality of what lies beyond is exposed.

Some of the finish work is cosmetic, some is the final installation of ordered pieces (women's bathroom vanity), and there are some re-dos and do-overs.

But once everything gets finished, here's what the Board has prioritized for planning and/or starting in 2012 along with some projects that are just starting. This list does not include regular or routine maintenance and repairs.

Scheduled: Brick BBQ remodel and upgrade, outdoor pool shower repair, south fence replacement, big tree next to south fence removal, pool light on 20 foot pole, teen room remodel, pool fence repair,

Planning, designing, and cost estimates for this year (work could also begin this year): clubhouse remodel, kitchen remodel, entry remodel, pool tile repair, bocce ball court near south fence (where the old shuffle board court was), fitness room.
